Isaiah 6:1-13

Follow Up on Last Week's Response

1. How can you express God's gritty, sacrificial love and grace to others this week?
2. Is there any person or group that you don't think deserve God's grace and mercy? If so, what will you do?
3. How will you respond to this passage in your relationship with God (Up)? In your relationship with those in the church (In)? Or, in your relationship with those outside the church (Out)?

Read the Passage(s): Isaiah 6:1-13

Introduction

1. What comes to mind when you think of holiness?
2. What is one gift God has given you to serve and bless the world with?

What Does it Say? (Context? Who? What? Where? How? Why? When?)

1. Who is Isaiah? What significant event happened the year he has this vision? (vs. 1)
2. Describe Isaiah's vision. (vs. 1-4)
3. What is Isaiah's response to the vision? Why? (vs. 5)
4. What surprising thing does God do for Isaiah? (vs. 6-9a)
5. What is Isaiah sent to do? For how long? (vs. 9b-13)

What Does it Mean?

1. What does Isaiah's vision tell us about God? What is God's holiness? (vs. 1-4)
2. How does God's holy presence effect people? How does Jesus demonstrate that? (vs. 5-7)
3. What does the burning coal signify in Isaiah's transformation? (vs. 6-7)
4. What is God's purpose for transforming His people? (vs. 6-9a)
5. Why does God send his people, his church, into the world? (vs. 8-13; Matt. 28:18-20)
6. How long are we to keep doing what God sends us to do? What determines our "success?" (vs. 9-13)

1. How will you use a unique gift God's given you to serve and bless the world this week?
2. How can you respond to this passage in your relationship with God (Up)? In your relationship with those in the church (In)? Or, in your relationship with those outside the church (Out)?
