



How to use Pod Talk:

Talking through the Bible during the week helps us practice what we are learning. Read the Sunday Bible passage, discuss what you notice, share what God is inviting you to apply to your life, and wrap up with prayer. **(SOAP)**

Sermon Main Idea:

The Lord wants us to become more like Him, not just do more for Him, in response to His grace. His desire is for us to become people of justice, mercy and humility.

Introduction:

1. What causes oppression and injustice in the world?
2. What are some examples of the oppression and injustice you see in the world?

SOAP:

Scripture | read Micah 6:6-8 and relate last week's daily bible readings

Observation | what do we notice? what stands out?

1. Who is Micah? (Micah 1:1)
2. What appeal does the Lord make to Israel? (Micah 6:1-5)
3. How do the people respond to the Lord's accusations? Why? (vs. 6-7)
4. How has the Lord already shown them what is good? (vs. 8)
5. What does the Lord seek for His Covenant People? (vs. 8)

Application | what can we apply to our life today?

1. Do you focus on doing more for the Lord or becoming more like the Lord? Why? (vs. 6-8)
2. What does it mean to do justice? Love mercy? Walk humbly with God? How are they related?
3. How can you grow in becoming a person of justice? A person of mercy? A person of humility?
4. What steps can you take this week to do justice? To love mercy? To walk humbly with God?
5. How did Jesus do justice, love mercy and walk humbly with God? How can you emulate Him this week?
6. This week how can you keep going further Up, in your relationship with God? In, in your relationship with those in the church? Or, Out, in your relationship with those outside the church?

Prayer | ask God to help you live out your application
