



## How to use Pod Talk:

Talking through the Bible during the week helps us practice what we are learning. Read the Sunday Bible passage, discuss what you notice, share what God is inviting you to apply to your life, and wrap up with prayer. (SOAP)

## Sermon Main Idea:

Truly trusting in God's faithfulness requires an uncomfortable faith.

## Introduction:

1. When have you experienced the Lord's faithfulness? Or, what seemed to be His unfaithfulness?
2. What does it mean to you that God is faithful?

## SOAP:

**Scripture** | read Habakkuk 1:1-4; 2:1-4; 3:17-19 and relate last week's daily bible readings

**Observation** | what do we notice? what stands out?

1. What do we know about Habakkuk? (1:1; 3:1)
2. What is Habakkuk's initial complaint to the Lord? (1:1-4)
3. What does the Lord instruct Habakkuk to do in light of the looming invasion of Babylon? (2:1-4)
4. How does Habakkuk plan to respond to the coming difficulties? (3:17-19)
5. What is Habakkuk's hope in the coming difficulties? (3:17-19)

**Application** | what can we apply to our life today?

1. How do you generally respond when the Lord doesn't behave the way you think He should?
2. What happens when you don't wait for God's justice or for God to provide what you need in a given situation?
3. Do you tend to put your faith in better circumstances or in God's presence in the circumstances? Why?
4. In what current situation or circumstance can you seek the Lord more than the right circumstance?
5. What circumstances are you currently facing that require an uncomfortable faith? Why?
6. This week how can you keep going further Up, in your relationship with God? In, in your relationship with those in the church? Or, Out, in your relationship with those outside the church?

**Prayer** | ask God to help you live out your application
