



## How to use Pod Talk:

Talking through the Bible during the week helps us practice what we are learning. Read the Sunday Bible passage, discuss what you notice, share what God is inviting you to apply to your life, and wrap up with prayer. (SOAP)

## Sermon Main Idea:

We are to love the Lord with all of our intentions, comprehension, affections and actions; this is our life.

## Introduction:

1. How would you define or describe what love is?
2. Share an experience you have had with loving someone or being loved by someone.

## SOAP:

**Scripture** | read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and relate last week's daily bible readings

**Observation** | what do we notice? what stands out?

1. What is the setting of Deuteronomy? (vs. 1-3)
2. Why does Moses begin with the instruction to hear or listen? (vs. 4)
3. What statement is made about the Lord? (vs. 4)
4. How is Israel instructed to respond to the Lord's love and faithfulness? (vs. 5)
5. Why does the Lord command His people to love Him? (vs. 5)
6. What is Israel supposed to do with the Lord's commands? (vs. 6-9)

**Application** | what can we apply to our life today?

1. Why are we instructed to love the Lord with all we have, -- with every aspect of our humanity?
2. How can you love the Lord with more of your intentions (your will, choices)?
3. How can you love the Lord with more of your comprehension (your thinking, understanding)?
4. How can you love the Lord with more of your affections (your feelings, emotions)?
5. How can you love the Lord with more of your actions (your physical activity, strength)?
6. This week how can you keep going further Up, in your relationship with God? In, in your relationship with those in the church? Or, Out, in your relationship with those outside the church?

**Prayer** | ask God to help you live out your application
