



## How to use Pod Talk:

Talking through the Bible during the week helps us practice what we are learning. Read the Sunday Bible passage, discuss what you notice, share what God is inviting you to apply to your life, and wrap up with prayer. (SOAP)

## Sermon Main Idea:

When loving God is our life, we will pass our love for God on to others.

## Introduction:

1. What is something your parents have passed on to you?
2. As a parent, what would be something you would want to be sure to pass on to your children?

## SOAP:

**Scripture** | read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and relate last week's daily bible readings

**Observation** | what do we notice? what stands out?

1. What is the setting of Deuteronomy? (6:1-3)
2. How is Israel instructed to respond to the Lord's love and faithfulness? What does this mean? (vs. 5)
3. What is Israel supposed to do with the Lord's commands? (vs. 6-9)
4. Why does Moses specifically address what parents are to do with their children? (vs. 1-2;7)

**Application** | what can we apply to our life today?

1. What can compel us to pass our love for God on to others? What helps or hinders you in doing this?
2. Why is discipling, like parenting, an intentional process? How can you be more intentional in these areas? (Col. 1:28-29)
3. Why is discipling, like parenting, a relational process? How can you be more relational in these areas? (1 Thessalonians 2:6b-8;11-12)
4. Why is discipling, like parenting, a formational process? How can you be more formational in these areas? (Ephesians 4:11-13)
5. Why is discipling, like parenting, a biblical process? How can you be more biblical in these areas?
6. This week how can you keep going further Up, in your relationship with God? In, in your relationship with those in the church? Or, Out, in your relationship with those outside the church?

**Prayer** | ask God to help you live out your application
