



How to use Pod Talk:

Talking through the Bible during the week helps us practice what we are learning. Read the Sunday Bible passage, discuss what you notice, share what God is inviting you to apply to your life, and wrap up with prayer. (SOAP)

Sermon Main Idea:

I need to change, because our church needs to change, because our world needs to change.

Introduction:

1. When it comes to change, why do we primarily see the need for change in others?
2. What are some of the changes you think need to be made in our city or country?

SOAP:

Scripture | read Philippians 1:3-11 and relate last week's daily bible readings

Observation | what do we notice? what stands out?

1. Who is Paul writing this letter to? (vs. 1-2)
2. What is Paul thankful for and what gives him joy? (vs. 3-5)
3. What is Paul confident about for them? Why? (vs. 3-6)
4. Describe the relationship Paul has with the Philippians. (vs. 3-8)
5. What is Paul's prayer for the Philippians? (vs. 9-11)

Application | what can we apply to our life today?

1. In God's Kingdom, do you think that change in the world always begin with you? Why or why not?
2. In your current circumstances, what is something the Lord is wanting to change in you?
3. How can you participate with the Lord in bringing these changes about in you?
4. How do you see the changes the Lord wants to make in you impacting Riverside?
5. How can Riverside change so that it has more of an impact on our community and world?
6. This week how can you keep going further Up, in your relationship with God? In, in your relationship with those in the church? Or, Out, in your relationship with those outside the church?

Prayer | ask God to help you live out your application
