



How to use Pod Talk:

Talking through the Bible during the week helps us practice what we are learning. Read the Sunday Bible passage, discuss what you notice, share what God is inviting you to apply to your life, and wrap up with prayer. **(SOAP)**

Sermon Main Idea:

God loves us so much that He sent His Son Jesus to die, that whoever hears and believes can experience full and eternal life. God's heart is that *all* shall believe.

Introduction:

1. How did you first come to know Jesus as your Savior?
2. What questions did you have in the process, and how did you find the answers?

SOAP:

Scripture | read John 3:1-21 and relate last week's daily bible readings

Observation | what do we notice? what stands out?

1. What do you notice about Nicodemus's approach to Jesus? What strikes you about the questions he asks?
2. What stands out to you about Jesus's responses to Nicodemus?
3. Read Numbers 21:4-9. What was Jesus trying to communicate to Nicodemus about himself through this reference (v.14-15)? What do you think this might have stirred in Nicodemus?
4. How would verse 16 have been radical news to Nicodemus?
5. Compare and contrast what John says about darkness and light in verses 19-21 with the timing of Nicodemus's visit to Jesus.

Application | what can we apply to our life today?

1. How does being born again impact your thinking or living?
2. How can we prevent ourselves from living into the Pharisaical way of limiting the love of God that compelled Him to send His only Son to a select group of people like ourselves?
3. How might God be calling you to live into this deep love that he has for you?
4. Whose life might God be calling you to be His love and light to in a tangible way?
5. What hinders or prevents followers of Jesus from stepping into the light?
6. In what areas of your thinking or living do you need to step into the light?

Prayer | ask God to help you live out your application
