



## Sermon Main Idea:

Eternal Life is not something we acquire. It's someone we follow.

## Introduction:

1. What does it mean to believe in something?
2. What are some things in our culture and time that people believe in?

## SORP:

**Scripture** | read John 6:25-59 and relate last week's daily bible readings

**Observation** | what do we notice? what stands out?

1. What is something new or different that you noticed about this passage when you read it this time?
2. When the crowd found Jesus after he had fed 5000 people with five loaves and two fish, they asked, "What must we do to do the works God requires?" Why do you think they asked this?
3. In verse 30 the crowd asks Jesus to perform a sign, so that they can believe him...right after Jesus had performed the miracle of feeding 5000 people with five loaves and two fish. What does this say about the idea that "seeing is believing," if they saw and still didn't believe?
4. There were many times that the crowd misunderstood what Jesus was trying to say to them. What are some examples in this passage of this?
5. If the Bread of Life is Jesus, what did manna represent in this passage?

**Response** | how can we respond in our lives to what we learn?

1. The Jews kept comparing Jesus to Moses, as Moses is what they knew and had seen. What are some ways that we inaccurately compare Jesus to what we know and have seen, and in doing so, limit Him?
2. How do we "work for food that spoils" instead of the eternal that endures? (verse 27)
3. Jesus says that believing in Him is the work of God they are required to do. What are some things that trip you up in believing?
4. What are some practical things you can do to grow in your belief?
5. How do you feel God is calling you to respond to what He has shown you through this passage?

**Prayer** | ask God to help you live out your response
