What Lender Voluntarily Cuts Interest Rates?

National Covenant Properties (NCP), the source for Riverside's building loan, has voluntarily chosen to lower the church's interest rate by .5%. While not required to do so by the loan documents signed by the church, NCP has graciously decided to lower the interest rate on the loans of 69 Evangelical Covenant churches that entered into loan arrangements when interest rates were at their highest point in the past four years. The interest rate cut will save Riverside over \$1,500 in in-

terest charges over the next year. The President of National Covenant Properties, Steve Dawson, said, "the drop in interest payments will mean a manageable reduction in revenue to NCP, but the board made the move because we sensed it was the right thing to do."

In 2007, NCP made loans to more than 50 church projects with loan advances totaling \$35 million. Funds for these loans are obtained from NCP's sale of investment certificates. If you would like to invest

Thoughts From Pastor Dan

Just a few weeks ago Dana and I ran into someone we knew outside a store in West Lafayette. The conversation was very brief because it was windy and cold. This week the temperatures have risen and so have our opportunities to engage in conversations. In the past two days, we have already had fantastic opportunities to speak with our neighbors.

We can spend all the time in the world discussing how Riverside can share the Good News of Jesus Christ with our community, but if we really want to make it happen we have to take the time to speak with our neighbors, our coworkers, and our friends. Programs, sermons, music, coffee and donuts are nice, but people are most likely to come to Riverside if we care enough to tell them that the God of the universe is at work there.

We do not have to go door-to-door with our Bibles in one hand and a cross in the other. We simply have to love others. While we are often good at surface conversations about the weather and sports, we are reluctant to invest our time and heart in truly loving those we encounter.

Let's endeavor together to be intentional about entering into spiritual conversations with neighbors, coworkers and friends. With nice weather comes an increased opportunity for conversation in the front yard, work parking lot, at the park and on the golf course, to

name a few. Here are some simple suggestions on how to start discussions about your faith. Ask about the upcoming weekend, then when asked about your weekend, include your church attendance and something exciting that is happening at Riverside (Men's or Women's study, etc.). Spend time asking questions to learn about the motivations, desires and passions of others. Do not use Christian-ese (only Christians know what salvation, atonement, saved, born-again, etc. mean). Do not think you have to change someone's heart in one conversation, but be willing to plant seeds. Offer prayer, then follow-up by asking how things are going the next time you see them. Freely share what God is doing in your life and do not be afraid to give God the credit in your conversations.

To truly love someone is to be willing to share with them the greatest news you have ever heard, the Good News that God loves us and that Jesus Christ came to restore our relationship with God.

What brought you to Riverside and how long have you been here?

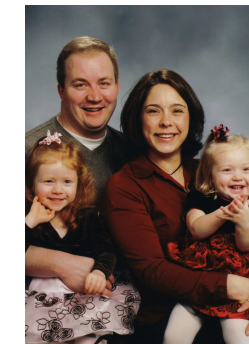
