## Directions to Training Camp

**From the south,**

**Traveling north on I-65**

Take the West Lafayette/Brookston exit #178, which is State Road 43 (turn right off the exit ramp). Travel north into Brookston. Turn right (east) on State Road 18. Go five miles east of Brookston until you come to an intersection with flashing yellow lights and a sign marked with a green highway sign for Camp Tecumseh. Turn left up a steep winding hill. Go .09 of a mile to the main camp entrance (third drive on right).

**From the north,**

**Traveling south on I-65**

Take the Brookston exit #188 east, which is State Road 18 (turn left off the exit ramp). In Brookston the road jogs to the right and then to the left to stay on State Road 18. Then go five miles east of Brookston on State Road 18, until you come to an intersection with flashing yellow lights and a sign marked with a green highway sign for Camp Tecumseh. Turn left up a steep winding hill. Go .09 of a mile to the main camp entrance (third drive on right).

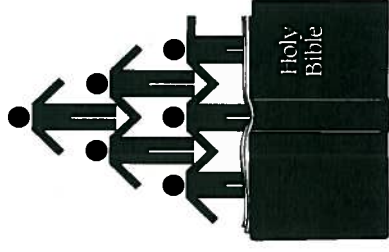
