2. Do you really believe that God desires to and will use you to bring others closer to Himself? If not, why? If so, why?
3. Read Luke 17:20-21. What is the kingdom of God? Why is it significant that the kingdom of God is in you?
4. Do you view the Gospel of Jesus Christ as something you deliver or present to someone or as something that you embody? Why is this distinction important? What Scripture supports your opinion?
5. Can you advance the kingdom of God if it is not advancing in you? How would 2 Timothy 3:16-17 relate to this?
6. Read 1 Samuel 12:19-23. Why would it be sinful for Samuel not to pray? (vs. 23) What does failing to pray reveal about our hearts?
7. What does it mean to really love non-Christians? What is our responsibility to those who reject Christ or our conversations about Him?
8. What do you believe happens to people who choose not to accept Jesus Christ? What does the Bible say? Do your actions or the urgency of your actions coincide with your belief?
9. In reading these chapters, what opportunities have you been missing every day? What are some practical ways that you can engage people that you would normally ignore?
